

During February 2020, the industrial producer price index registered an increase of 1.25 per cent when compared to the same month of the previous year.

## Industrial Producer Price Indices: February 2020

Cut-off date:  
**18 March 2020**

### Annual comparison

When compared to February 2019, the industrial producer price index went up by 1.25 per cent. This was due to a rise of 2.1 per cent in intermediate goods, 1.4 per cent in capital goods and 0.63 per cent in consumer goods. No price changes were registered in the energy sector.

Industrial producer prices for the domestic market increased by 0.57 per cent. Price rises were recorded within consumer goods (1.25 per cent), intermediate goods (0.79 per cent) and capital goods (0.18 per cent).

Non-domestic prices increased by 1.68 per cent due to increases of 1.83 per cent within the non-euro area and 1.38 per cent within the euro area (Table 2).

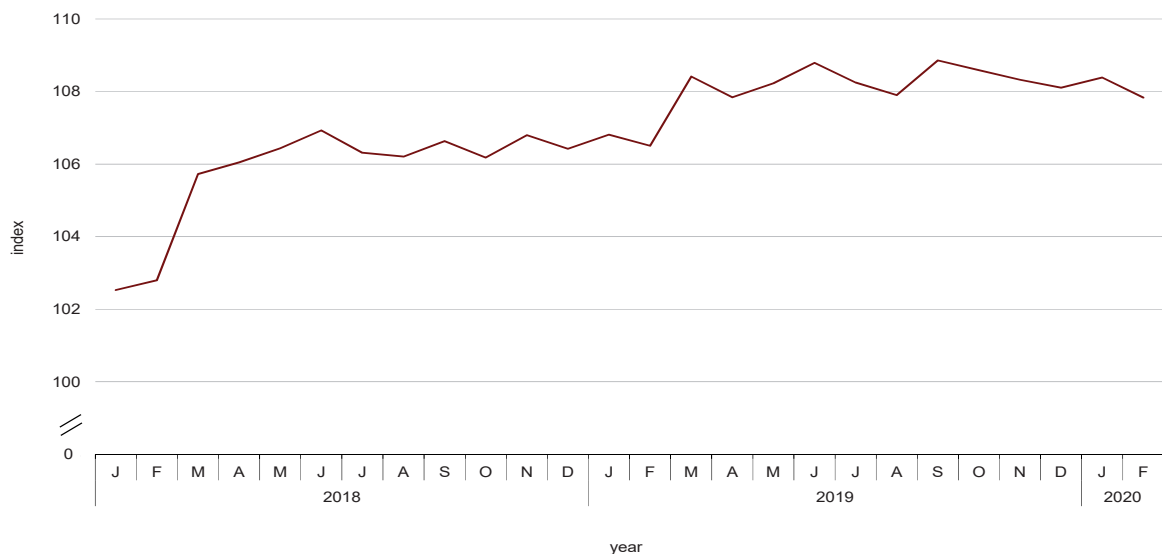
### Monthly comparison

During February 2020, the industrial producer price index registered a drop of 0.51 per cent over the previous month. This was due to price decreases of 1.27 per cent in intermediate goods. Consumer goods increased by 0.06 per cent while no price changes were registered in the capital and energy sectors.

Prices within the domestic market increased by 0.08 per cent due to rises of 0.15 per cent within consumer goods and 0.13 per cent within intermediate goods.

Non-domestic prices declined by 0.88 per cent due to drops of 1.12 per cent within the non-euro area and 0.39 per cent within the euro area (Table 3) ■

## Methodological Notes

1. The industrial producer price index monitors the changes in selling prices of all leading products within a sample of around 80 large enterprises which account for over 80 per cent of the total industrial turnover.
2. The pricing point for the monthly price collection is the 15th day of the month or the nearest trading day prior to that date.
3. The methodologies and guidelines used are set by Eurostat and the International Monetary Fund (IMF).
4. Euro area exports are transactions between Maltese enterprises and enterprises within the euro area. The euro area includes Austria, Belgium, Cyprus, Estonia (from 2011), Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Ireland, Italy, Latvia (from 2014), Lithuania (from 2015), Luxembourg, the Netherlands, Portugal, Slovakia, Slovenia, and Spain. These are classified as 'non-domestic euro-area'. The 'non-domestic non-euro area' covers transactions between Maltese enterprises and enterprises within the non-euro area. Examples include the USA and Sweden. The latter country is in the EU but does not use the euro currency. Transactions among local resident enterprises are considered 'domestic'.
5. The objective of Main Industrial Groupings (MIGs) is to provide an activity breakdown of industry using the internationally recognised classification of economic activities (NACE Rev. 2 Sections B, C, D and E) in terms of demand-based products: intermediate goods, energy, capital goods, durable consumer goods, and non-durable consumer goods. These regroup NACE Sections B to E and cover the following economic activities: quarrying, manufacturing, electricity and water.
6. Figures for the last three months are to be considered provisional and subject to revision. However, in exceptional cases, past data may also be revised.
7. The figures in this news release are unadjusted, that is, there are no working-day or seasonal adjustments.
